Summary (as of Jan 10, 2019)

Protect Utah's Rural Economy Act

This bill prohibits the President from establishing or extending national monuments in Utah unless:

- the proposed establishment or extension has been authorized by an Act of Congress, and
- the President has received a notice from the Governor of Utah that the state legislature has enacted legislation approving of the proposed establishment or extension.

- **Jan 10, 2019:** Introduced in Senate
- **Jan 10, 2019:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
