Summary (as of Dec 17, 2020)

Preserving Existing Nuclear Energy Generation Act

This bill provides for the establishment of (1) a program to evaluate nuclear reactors that are projected to cease operations due to economic factors and to allocate financial credits to certain reactors, and (2) a grant program to assist communities with revenue shortfalls due to closures of nuclear power plants.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 18, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Dec 17, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 17, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
