Summary (as of Jan 30, 2019)

School Resource Officer Act of 2019

This bill reauthorizes through FY2023 the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) program and modifies it:

- to restore authority to make COPS grants for hiring and rehiring additional career law enforcement officers, and
- to specify that at least 30% of the amount made available for such grants must be used for school resource officers.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 22, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Jan 30, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 30, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
