This resolution calls on all governments to permanently close live wildlife markets.

The resolution also calls on the World Health Organization to advise member states to close live wildlife markets around the world.

Finally, the resolution calls on the Chinese Communist Party officials and the propaganda organs of the Chinese Communist Party to cease spreading disinformation on the origins of, and initial response to, the coronavirus (i.e., the virus that causes COVID-19).

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 20, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife.
- **Apr 14, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 14, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
