This bill directs the Commodity Futures Trading Commission to report on virtual currency markets and U.S. competitiveness.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 25, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Commodity Exchanges, Energy, and Credit.
- **Jan 30, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 30, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
