This resolution adopts H.Res. 935 (establishes the Select Subcommittee on the Coronavirus Crisis as a select investigative subcommittee of the Committee on Oversight and Reform).

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 23, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 23, 2020:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 116-419, by Mr. McGovern.
- **Apr 23, 2020:** Rule provides for consideration of H. Res. 935 with 1 hour of general debate.
- **Apr 23, 2020:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 77.
- **Apr 23, 2020:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H1907-1920)
- **Apr 23, 2020:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 938.
- **Apr 23, 2020:** The previous question was ordered without objection.
- **Apr 23, 2020:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 938, the Chair put the question on agreeing to the resolution, and by voice vote, announced that ayes had prevailed. Mr. Cole demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on agreeing to the resolution until a time to be announced.

- **Apr 23, 2020:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 212 - 182 (Roll no. 103).(text: CR H1907)
