Summary (as of Feb 6, 2019)

Promoting Apprenticeships through Regional Training Networks for Employers Required Skills Act of 2019 or the PARTNERS Act

This bill establishes a grant program to promote registered apprenticeships and other work-based learning opportunities for small and medium-sized businesses within in-demand industry sectors, through the establishment and support of eligible partnerships.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 22, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration and Citizenship.
- **Feb 6, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 6, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
