Summary (as of Feb 11, 2021)

Infection Control Training and Support Act of 2021

This bill provides funds to support the development and distribution of protocols to control COVID-19 (i.e., coronavirus disease 2019) in Medicare skilled nursing facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 12, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 11, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 11, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Feb 11, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
