Summary (as of Mar 25, 2021)

Crumbling Foundations Small Business and Homeowners Assistance Act of 2021

This bill requires the Federal Emergency Management Agency to award grants for states to assist homeowners, small-business owners, and condominium associations in preventing, mitigating, and repairing structural damage to concrete foundations that contain pyrrhotite (an iron sulfide mineral linked to crumbling foundations).
