This bill provides statutory authority for Executive Order 13920, which set forth requirements related to securing the U.S. bulk-power system.

- **Feb 18, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 18, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Foreign Affairs, and Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
