## Summary (as of Feb 18, 2021)

### Broadband Competition and Efficient Deployment Act

This bill excludes the deployment or modification of certain telecommunications service facility projects from specified review requirements.

Specifically, the bill excludes from specified environmental and historic preservation review a project for the placement, construction, or modification of a telecommunications service facility in or on infrastructure that supports or houses a facility for communication by wire.

- **Feb 19, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change.
- **Feb 18, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 18, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
