This resolution makes various statements related to the insurrection at the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021. Among other things, the resolution

- determines that the Proud Boys have engaged in acts of domestic terrorism, including at the U.S. Capitol;
- adjudges that the insurrection involved acts of domestic terrorism; and
- condemns the instigating role of the Proud Boys organization in the insurrection.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 11, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 11, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
