Forest Information Reform Act or the FIR Act

This bill specifies that neither the Department of Agriculture nor the Department of the Interior may be required to reinitiate consultation on a land management plan when a species is listed as threatened or endangered, critical habitat is designated, or new information concerning a listed species or critical habitat becomes available.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 25, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Mar 23, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Mar 23, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife.
- **Feb 18, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 18, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
