Actions Timeline

- **Jun 16, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 16, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 16, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Asia, the Pacific, Central Asia and Nonproliferation.
