Summary (as of Feb 22, 2021)

Stop Online Ammunition Sales Act of 2021

This bill establishes new requirements and restrictions with respect to the sale, purchase, shipment, and transport of ammunition.

Among other things, the bill

- requires an ammunition dealer to be licensed;
- requires ammunition sales to be conducted in person; and
- requires a licensed ammunition importer, manufacturer, or dealer to report on bulk sales of ammunition.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 28, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Feb 22, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 22, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
