Summary (as of Sep 22, 2022)

This resolution directs the Department of Homeland Security to provide the House of Representatives with certain documents and information about the impact of illegal immigration on federal or Tribal lands, such as the level of environmental damage along the Southern border and communications regarding the transport of illicit drugs and drug cartel activity.
