Summary (as of Apr 21, 2021)

Hydrogen Utilization and Sustainability Act

This bill expands the tax credit for producing electricity from renewable resources to include qualified hydrogen. The bill defines *qualified hydrogen* as hydrogen fuel certified as having a carbon intensity of not greater than 75 grams of CO₂e (carbon dioxide equivalent) per kilowatt hour of electricity produced, as determined based on a lifecycle analysis.
