## Summary (as of Jun 29, 2021)

### Global Learning Loss Assessment Act of 2021

This bill requires the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) to report on the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the agency's basic education programs.

This report shall include (1) an assessment of the global learning loss that will result from protracted school closures; (2) evaluations of the effectiveness, cost, accessibility, and reach of the most commonly used forms of distance learning in low- and middle-income countries; and (3) a description of the resources needed for the USAID to support continued distance learning, safe school reopenings, remedial and accelerated learning, and reenrollment campaigns.

### Actions Timeline

- **Jul 12, 2021:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations.
- **Jun 29, 2021:** Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 504, proceedings on H.R. 1500 are considered vacated.
- **Jun 29, 2021:** Passed/agreed to in House: Pursuant to section 8 of H. Res. 504, and the motion offered by Mr. McGovern, the following bills passed under suspension of the rules: H.R. 1500, as amended; H.R. 2471, as amended; H.R. 3261; H.R. 3283, as amended; and H.R. 3385, as amended; and the following resolutions were agreed to under suspension of the rules: H. Res. 186; and H. Res. 402, as amended.(consideration: CR H3258-3262; text: CR H3258)
- **Jun 29, 2021:** Pursuant to section 8 of H. Res. 504, and the motion offered by Mr. McGovern, the following bills passed under suspension of the rules: H.R. 1500, as amended; H.R. 2471, as amended; H.R. 3261; H.R. 3283, as amended; and H.R. 3385, as amended; and the following resolutions were agreed to under suspension of the rules: H. Res. 186; and H. Res. 402, as amended. (consideration: CR H3258-3262; text: CR H3258)
- **Jun 29, 2021:** The title of the measure was amended. Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 28, 2021:** Mr. Meeks moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended.
- **Jun 28, 2021:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H3183-3185; text: CR H3183)
- **Jun 28, 2021:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 1500.
- **Jun 28, 2021:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
