Providing Accountability Through Transparency Act of 2021

This bill requires the notice of a proposed rule by a federal agency to include the internet address of a summary of the rule. The summary must be 100 words or fewer, written in plain language, and posted on regulations.gov.

Actions Timeline

- **May 18, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Antitrust, Commercial, and Administrative Law.
- **Mar 2, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 2, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
