Actions Timeline

- **Dec 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 7, 2022:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 117-608, by Ms. Scanlon.
- **Dec 7, 2022:** The resolution makes in order a motion offered by the chair of the Committee on the Judiciary or his designee that the House concur in the Senate amendment to H.R. 8404. All points of order against consideration of the motion are waived. Rule provides for one hour of general debate.
