Summary (as of Dec 14, 2022)

This resolution supports the designation of National Wreaths Across America Day and honors the Wreaths Across America project, patriotic escort units, the U.S. trucking industry, and the volunteers and donors involved in this tradition. Additionally, the resolution recognizes the service and sacrifices of veterans, members of the Armed Forces, and their families.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 15, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit.
- **Dec 14, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 14, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Armed Services, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
