Lake Tahoe Restoration Reauthorization Act

This bill reauthorizes through September 30, 2034, activities to restore Lake Tahoe and its surrounding basin. Lake Tahoe is a large freshwater lake on the border of California and Nevada.

- **Feb 28, 2022:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Reported by Senator Manchin without amendment. With written report No. 117-85.
- **Feb 28, 2022:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 286.
- **Nov 18, 2021:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Ordered to be reported without amendment favorably.
- **Oct 19, 2021:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources Subcommittee on Public Lands, Forests, and Mining. Hearings held.
- **May 12, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
- **May 12, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
