Summary (as of May 13, 2021)

Local School Foods Expansion Act of 2021

This bill expands and otherwise revises a program to support state procurement of domestically grown unprocessed fruits and vegetables under the National School Lunch Program.

Specifically, the bill expands the number of participating states from a maximum of 8 to a maximum of 14 and establishes additional requirements with respect to priorities, reporting, and evaluations, including with respect to socially disadvantaged populations and the program's economic impact.

The bill provides funds for the program through FY2026.

Actions Timeline

- **May 13, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry.
