Summary (as of Mar 9, 2021)

Jack Reynolds Memory MediGap Expansion

This bill expands guaranteed issue rights with respect to Medigap policies (Medicare supplemental health insurance policies) to all beneficiaries with end-stage renal disease. (Guaranteed issue rights require that a policy be offered to any eligible applicant without regard to health status.)

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 10, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 9, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 9, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Mar 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
