Summary (as of Mar 12, 2021)

Environmental Justice for Coronavirus Affected Communities Act

This bill reauthorizes through FY2022 (1) the Environmental Justice Small Grants Program; (2) the Environmental Justice Collaborative Problem-Solving Cooperative Agreement Program, which provides financial assistance to address local environmental or public health issues; and (3) the Community Action for a Renewed Environment grant program, which assists communities address multiple sources of toxic pollutants.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 16, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change.
- **Mar 12, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 12, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
