Ka'ena Point National Heritage Area Act

This bill directs the Department of the Interior to conduct a study to assess the suitability and feasibility of designating Honolulu County, Hawaii, as a National Heritage Area, to be known as the Ka'ena Point National Heritage Area.

- **Mar 16, 2022:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.

- **Mar 15, 2022:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 1908.
