Summary (as of Jun 15, 2021)

Local Water Protection Act

This bill reauthorizes through FY2026 grants to states for (1) programs that manage and control nonpoint source pollution (e.g., runoff from a variety of sources) added to navigable waters, and (2) groundwater quality protection activities to advance state implementation of such programs.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 16, 2021:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works.
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Ms. Norton moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.

- **Jun 15, 2021:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 2008.
