Interagency Committee on Women's Business Enterprise Act of 2022

This bill revises the duties, membership, and reporting requirements of the Interagency Committee on Women's Business Enterprise.

These changes include striking a requirement that the committee develop and promote new public sector programs and plans to foster women's business enterprise and, instead, requiring it to monitor the plans, programs, and operations of federal government departments and agencies to identify barriers to new business formation by women entrepreneurs.

- **Feb 17, 2022:** Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship. Reported by Senator Cardin with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. Without written report.
- **Feb 17, 2022:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 279.
- **Feb 15, 2022:** Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Oct 27, 2021:** Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship. Hearings held.
- **Jun 14, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
