#### Red Tape Reduction Act

This bill grants the force and effect of law to various executive orders relating to administrative procedures that were rescinded on January 20, 2021, including orders requiring agencies to (1) identify at least two regulations for repeal before publishing notice of a proposed new rule, and (2) rescind guidance documents that are no longer in effect.

#### Actions Timeline

---

- **Oct 19, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Antitrust, Commercial, and Administrative Law.
- **Apr 1, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 1, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
