### Summary (as of Apr 1, 2021)

#### **Building Rural Investments, Development, and Growth for the Economy Act or the BRIDGE Act**

This bill requires the Department of Commerce and the Department of State to promote the export of goods and services by small- and medium-sized businesses from, and facilitate business investment in, rural areas of the United States. A *rural area* is an area with a population of less than 50,000 inhabitants that is outside an urbanized area.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **Apr 2, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Apr 1, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 1, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
