### Summary (as of Jul 15, 2021)

This bill requires the Small Business Administration to revise the rules for the Restaurant Revitalization program to enable certain distilleries that are prohibited from meeting on-site sales requirements to participate in the program. The program provides support to eligible food and beverage purveyors to cover specified costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
