Summary (as of Apr 8, 2021)

Medicare & You Handbook Improvement Act of 2021

This bill specifically requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to describe the types of prior authorization requirements and other utilization management requirements that may apply under Medicare in the Medicare & You handbook, including how to inquire about requirements under Medicare Advantage or prescription drug plans.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Apr 8, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 8, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Apr 8, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
