Summary (as of Apr 8, 2021)

Broadband for All Act of 2021

This bill allows a refundable tax credit of up to \$10,000 per year for 75% of a taxpayer's payments for broadband infrastructure in certain areas (limited broadband districts) that are not served by a provider of qualified broadband service (other than providers using satellite technology). *Qualified broadband service* is Internet access service at download speeds of at least 25 megabits per second and upload speeds of at least 3 megabits per second.
