More Help for Seniors Act of 2021

This bill expands eligibility for low-income subsidies under the Medicare prescription drug benefit. Specifically, the bill raises the maximum allowable income for beneficiaries to qualify from 150% to 200% of the federal poverty line.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 14, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Apr 13, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 13, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Apr 13, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
