Summary (as of Jul 29, 2021)

Protect Collaboration for Healthier Forests Act

This bill directs the Forest Service to establish an arbitration pilot program as an alternative dispute resolution process in lieu of judicial review for the arbitration of projects in Idaho, Montana, or Wyoming that

- are developed through a collaborative process, are carried out under the Collaborative Forest Landscape Restoration Program, or are identified in a community wildfire protection plan;
- have as a purpose hazardous fuels reduction or mitigation of insect or disease infestation; and
- are located in a wildland-urban interface.

- **Jul 29, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
- **Jul 29, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
