Restoring Environments, Soils, Trees, and Operations to develop the Rural Economy Act of 2021 or the RESTORE Act of 2021

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture (USDA), at the request of a governor of a state, to select a forest landscape in the state on which to conduct a forest landscape project. For a project, USDA must carry out one or more specified management activities, including installing fuel breaks, conducting controlled burns, and removing dead trees.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 19, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Courts, Intellectual Property, and the Internet.
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jun 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Apr 16, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 16, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
