Summary (as of Dec 5, 2022)

Inspector General Independence and Empowerment Act of 2021

This bill addresses issues regarding inspectors general (IGs).

For example, if the President fails to make a formal nomination for a vacant IG position within a certain timeline, the bill requires the President to communicate to Congress the reasons for such a failure and a target date for the nomination.

- **Jul 12, 2021:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
