Commission on United States Occupations Act or the La Comisión de las ocupaciones norteamericanas Act

This bill establishes the Commission to Study and Develop Reconciliation Proposals for Dominican Republic.

The commission must address specified U.S. actions related to the Dominican Republic (e.g., military occupations and efforts to annex the Dominican Republic) and make recommendations for appropriate remedies, including a formal apology and repair and reconciliation efforts.
