### Summary (as of Apr 22, 2021)

#### Sugary Drinks Tax Act of 2021 or the SWEET Act

This bill imposes an excise tax on the sale or transfer of any specified sugary drink product. The bill defines *specified sugary drink product* as any liquid intended for human consumption that contains a caloric sweetener (i.e., monosaccharides, disaccharides, and high-fructose corn syrup), with specified exceptions. The bill provides for the transfer of revenues from the tax for the benefit of the School Breakfast Program.
