### Summary (as of Apr 22, 2021)

#### Mitigate Methane Now Act

This bill directs the Department of Energy to establish a program to provide grants to states; the grants may be used to offset rate increases that result from infrastructure improvements to natural gas distribution systems and that are paid by low-income households.
