## Summary (as of Sep 23, 2021)

### Transparency in COVID-19 Vaccination Act

This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to publicly disclose information about all adverse events that have arisen from COVID-19 vaccines, the statistical occurrence of such events, and adverse effects from clinical trials or other studies.
