Stop Vaccine Mandates Act

This bill rescinds the executive order titled *Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors* and the executive order titled *Requiring Coronavirus Disease 2019 Vaccination for Federal Employees*, both published on September 9, 2021. The bill provides that these executive orders shall have no force or effect.
