Summary (as of Dec 19, 2022)

Federal Information Security Modernization Act of 2021

This bill addresses federal information security management, notification and remediation of cybersecurity incidents.

For example, the bill requires (1) the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency to perform ongoing and continuous assessments of federal information security risk posture; and (2) federal agencies to take certain actions in response to information security breaches, such as notifying affected individuals.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 19, 2022:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Reported by Senator Peters with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. With written report No. 117-274.
- **Dec 19, 2022:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 673.
- **Oct 6, 2021:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Sep 29, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
- **Sep 29, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
