Rail Passenger Fairness Act

This bill authorizes the National Railroad Passenger Corporation (Amtrak) to bring a civil action in a U. S. District Court to enforce its preference rights over freight transportation in using a rail line, junction, or crossing.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Courts, Intellectual Property, and the Internet.
- **May 3, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **Apr 30, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 30, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
