Summary (as of Apr 30, 2021)

Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Rebate Act of 2021

This bill requires the Department of Energy to establish a rebate program to encourage investment in electric vehicle charging infrastructure. The program must provide rebates for certain expenses associated with electric vehicle supply equipment located at workplaces, multi-unit housing structures, and publicly accessible locations.

- **Apr 30, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on Energy and Commerce.
