Educational Partnerships for Innovation in Communities Program Authorization Act

This bill requires the Department of Transportation, in coordination with the Department of Housing and Urban Development, to award a competitive grant to a nonprofit organization to train and support institutions of higher education (IHEs) in assisting local governments by leveraging existing graduate and undergraduate classes for projects of need.

Project of need refers to a project that (1) is identified by a local government that would benefit from the expertise of an IHE's faculty and students, and (2) advances a sustainable development goal (e.g., a goal related to climate change and housing affordability).

- **May 5, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit.
- **May 5, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **May 4, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 4, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, Financial Services, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
