Summary (as of Oct 19, 2021)

Comprehensive and Overdue Support for Troops of War Act of 2021 or the COST of War Act of 2021

This bill addresses health care and the presumption of service-connection for certain conditions in veterans who were exposed to toxic substances during service in the Armed Forces.

Actions Timeline
