Summary (as of May 7, 2021)

This bill expands a provision that prohibits China from participating in certain naval exercises until specified conditions are met.

In addition to the already existing conditions, China may not participate in the naval exercises until the Department of State certifies that China's government has (1) stopped committing any ongoing genocide, (2) apologized for such genocide, and (3) engaged in a credible justice and accountability process for the victims.

Actions Timeline

- **May 7, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 7, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
