No Communist Countries Participating in Lobbying Act

This bill prohibits former Members of Congress from lobbying the federal government on behalf of communist countries (or entities that are owned or controlled by such countries) and establishes specific monetary penalties for violations.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties.
- **May 7, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 7, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
