Summary (as of May 7, 2021)

Public Health Service Ready Reserve Improvement Act of 2021

This bill entitles members of the Ready Reserve Corps of the Public Health Service to certain rights and benefits concerning leave and pay that are provided to members of the Army Reserve and the National Guard who are employed by the federal government or the government of the District of Columbia. The Ready Reserve Corps provides trained personnel to respond to health emergencies and improve access to health services.

Actions Timeline

- **May 10, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 7, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 7, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
